SUBJECT: MAILBOX REPLACEMENT	

Citizens can choose one of the following options for mailbox replacement damaged by our operation:

- 1. The Road Commission will exchange a mailbox and/or post that have been damaged by our operation with a regular type 1, 3, or 5, depending on the size of the original mailbox. The post will be replaced with a 4" x 4" x 6' treated wood post or a steel post, whichever type was damaged. It will be the property owner's responsibility to bring in the damaged mailbox and/or post for replacement. These items will be left with the Road Commission. The Road Commission will not install these posts and/or mailboxes.
- 2. The Road Commission will pay the citizen \$30.00 in lieu of the new mailbox and/or post, with the checks being processed with the normal billing periods. It will be the property owner's responsibility to bring in the damaged mailbox and/or post for payment. These items will be left with the Road Commission. The Road Commission will not install these posts and/or mailboxes.
- 3. The Road Commission does not authorize the placement of mailbox snow shields, protectors or guards. The Road Commission will not replace the materials and will not pay for any mailbox snow shields, protectors, or guards damaged from our operations.
