CRACK SEALING MATERIAL – POLYMER BASED ONLY

Material to be free flowing, self-leveling, high adhesive and flexible product that resists cracking in winter and flow at summer temperatures. Material will be applied using a pressure feed melter applicator.

Price to be per pound and include all delivery charges to Gratiot County Road Commission.

The Commission reserves the right to purchase material from any and/or all bidders when in their opinion said purchases are in the best interest of the Gratiot County Road Commission.

**Proposals should be in a sealed envelope marked “CRACK SEALING MATERIAL”.
Price shall remain firm through March 1, 2026.**

The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any part of or all bids and/or quotations and to waive any informality in the bidding which in their opinion will be beneficial to the County of Gratiot.
